Adaptive & Inclusive Recreation Services consists of five programs:


Inclusion Services

Individualized supports for patrons experiencing disability in the registered class(es) of their choice. Available at recreation centers throughout the district.

Therapeutic Recreation (TR)

A recreation program for patrons 14+ years of age and older with developmental disabilities. Weekly events and off-site activities are offered throughout the year.

Inclusive Recreation Classes

Inclusive recreation classes for children and adults with and without disabilities are offered at recreation centers throughout the district. Inclusive classes are marked with a 

Camp Rivendale

A summer day camp providing recreational opportunities for patrons who have physical, emotional, and/or developmental disabilities. The camp runs during the summer for campers ages 6 to 21 and then for adults ages 22 and older.

Adaptive Recreation

A recreation and sports program for children with physical and developmental disabilities. Classes are offered throughout the year for ages 4 to adult.

Summer Camps

Camp Rivendale

Camp Rivendale is a summer day camp program providing recreational opportunities for children and adults who have physical, emotional, and/or developmental disabilities. Campers are encouraged to explore areas of music, dance, drama, visual arts, sports and aquatics. Each week campers will go on a field trip or off-site excursion.

Camp Rivendale is structured to foster physical, social, and emotional growth. Weekly activities are designed to help campers enhance social skills, communication, independence, and motor skills. Staff and volunteers foster peer relations, which allows campers to share affection, support, and companionship. Through community engagement, Camp Rivendale strives to develop community support and encourage attitude changes to reflect dignity, self-respect, and independence for individuals with disabilities. **Camp Rivendale is divided into three subgroups:**

Chipmunks

For campers ages 6-12 with physical and/or developmental disabilities. This program is held at the Jenkins Estate, 8005 SW Grabhorn Rd. Beaverton, OR 97007

A-Team

For campers ages 13-21 with physical and/or developmental disabilities. This program is held at the Jenkins Estate, 8005 SW Grabhorn Rd. Beaverton, OR 97007

Adults

For campers age 22+ with physical and/or developmental disabilities.

Appropriate subgroup placement of each camper is determined by staff. **Registration is accepted by phone-in, walk-in, online and email.**

Registration Process

At the initial registration, please sign up for the weeks of camp you are interested in attending. No payment is due at the time of sign-up. THPRD staff will then contact you and provide you with the 2018 camper application, or you can find it online at www.thprd.org/camprivendale. Once a completed camper application has been received, staff will contact you to complete the registration process.

Camp Rivendale Deposits and Balances: Fees for Week 1 for both youth and adults will be due in full at the completion of the registration process. The balance of all other weeks will be due by 4 pm on Monday, one week prior to the start date of each camp week.

Out-of-District assessment fee: \$86/per term per family. ID/SRD: In-district/Specialized recreation discount; OD/AP: Out-of-District, assessment paid; OD: Out-of-district, no assessment paid

Wilderness Camp is a summer day camp program held at the Tualatin Hills Athletic Center (15707 SW Walker Rd. Beaverton, OR 97006) dedicated to providing recreational opportunities for children ages 6-14, who demonstrate maladaptive behaviors as primary condition of their disability. Campers are encouraged to explore areas of music, dance, drama, visual arts, sports and aquatics. Each week campers will go on a field trip or off-site excursion.

Wilderness Camp is structured to foster positive peer interaction, self-confidence, as well as social, and emotional growth. Outdoor based activities are designed to help campers enhance social skills, communication, and independence. Each day consistent of activities and games designed to promote team work, independence and positive communication skills.

Registration Process:

At the initial registration, please sign up for the weeks of camp you are interested in attending. No payment is due at the time of sign-up. THPRD staff will then contact you and provide you with the 2018 camper application, or you can find it online at www.thprd.org/camprivendale. Once completed camper application has been received, staff will contact you to complete the registration process.

Wilderness Camp Deposits and Balances: Fees for Week 1 will be due in full at the completion of the registration process. The balance of all other weeks will be due by 4 pm on Monday, one week prior to the start date of each camp week.
