Life Cycle: Perennial
Height: 6-16 inches
Habitat: Grows in
light woods and open
meadows at low
elevations.

Flowering Time:
Early Spring
Life Cycle: Perennial
Height: 4-18 inches
Habitat: Grows in
cool moist mixed
woods and coniferous
forests.

Flowering Time:
Early Spring
Life Cycle: Perennial
Height: 2-3 feet
Habitat: Grows in
lightly shaded, open
mixed woods at low to
mid elevations.

Delphinium leucophaeum White Rock Larkspur



Flowering Time:
Late Spring
Life Cycle: Perennial
Height: 1 foot
Habitat: Grows in
loose, shallow soils
typically in prairies and
along bluffs in open
areas atop basaltic
shelves.

Flowering Time:
Mid Spring
Life Cycle: Perennial
Height: 6-26 inches
Habitat: Grows in moist meadows that dry out by summer at low to high elevations.

Dodecatheon hendersonii
Henderson's Shooting Star



Flowering Time:
Early Spring
Life Cycle: Perennial
Height: 5-16 inches
Habitat: Grows in open woods, grassy or shady sites, in moist to dry areas below 6500 feet.

Iris tenax
Toughleaf ore Oregon Iris



Flowering Time:
Late Spring
Life Cycle: Perennial
Height: 8-14 inches
Habitat: Grows in wet meadows and along oak woodland edges.

Lilium columbianum
Columbia or Tiger Lily



Flowering Time:
Early Summer
Life Cycle: Perennial
Height: 1-4 (6) feet
Habitat: Grows in drier coastal meadows, forests, roadsides, subalpine meadows in northern part of range.

Calochortus elegans
**Elegant Cat's Ear or
Elegant Mariposa Lily**



Flowering Time:
Late Spring to Early Summer
Life Cycle: Perennial
Height: 3-6 inches
Habitat: Grows in open, rocky soils at edges of forests at mid to high elevations.

Fritillaria affinis
Chocolate Lily



Flowering Time:
Mid spring
Life Cycle: Perennial
Height: 1-2 feet
Habitat: Grows in sheltered edges of forests.
