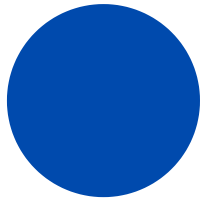

Circle

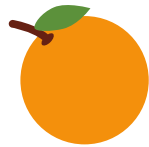
A circle has only one side - a long curved line



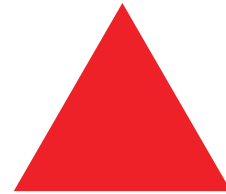
Beach Ball

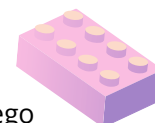


Rectangle



