## **Summer Registration Opens Saturday, May 1**

Camp Options Available Online April 12 -

**February 22, 2021:** Registration for Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District's summer camps, programs, classes and activities begins **Saturday, May 1, at 8 am** for in-district residents. Out-of-district registration begins on Monday, May 3.

- Camp Information Available Online April 12<sup>th</sup>: THPRD will be offering a wide range of
  camp options throughout the district. Full-day and half-day options are available. Options
  include sports play, nature camps, themed camps, and more. Camps available for
  preschool age through pre-teen. Details will be available on the district's website

  summer.

  - Make sure you have your username and password set up so you are ready.
  - Update your username: If you haven't yet, please update your username. Starting
    in the Spring of 2020, all THPRD accounts were required to have an updated
    username that does not include your name/date of birth combination.
- In-person at one of our facilities: Walk-in registration at our open facilities is allowed starting on Saturday, May 1, for in-district patrons that need extra help. The website's registration portal is still the preferred and quickest method, but if you need the help, come on in. Facilities open at different hours, and not all centers are currently open to the public, so be sure to check the opening times on our web site.
- New this Term: Expanding Centro de Bienvenida: We have expanded our special registration assistance center to serve additional languages. We continue to have bilingual staff and volunteers serving Spanish-speaking patrons. This term we are partnering with community-based organizations to accommodate even more languages. Details are still being finalized, but we anticipate having in-person translation for Arabic, Farsi, Somali, and more. All non-English speakers needing extra assistance are encouraged to attend this event. Running from 7:30 am to 12:00 pm on Saturday, May 1 at THPRD's Howard M. Terpenning Complex at 15707 SW Walker Rd.
